The cookoff/festival features some of the finest music available on the BBQ circuit, as well as plenty of kid's activities, arts & crafts, and FOOD. Please read on for some of the more pertinent BBQ related information.

- Check-in starts at 10am Friday morning at Check Point Chicky. **Please follow directions via the map on our web site or the map you will receive in your confirmation.**
- Meat inspection can take place as soon as you are in your assigned space.
- A cooks meeting will be in the judging tent at 6:30pm or 7pm Friday evening. Exact time of cooks' meeting will be contained in the confirmation e- mail, as well as posted the day of the event.
- Electricity **IS NOT** available. Use of generators will be allowed.
- Water and ice will be available at central locations. Teams must provide water containers. Attempts will be made to assist you in hauling water and delivering ice.
- **PLEASE dispose of GREASE in appropriate containers (barrels) supply by ROOTS FEST!**
- Awards will be announced promptly at 3:00pm Saturday afternoon.

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BBQ GUIDELINES & RULES

I would like to welcome you to the 2010 Roots Festival. This year will be set-up just like last year with the stage being on the East side of the square. After filling out your application make sure that all applications are returned to Steve McMullin. We have 65 spots available for the BBQ contest so get your application in early. There are a few things you should be aware of before coming to the Roots Festival BBQ Cook-off.

1. Check-in will begin at 10 a.m. on Friday at Check Point Chicky. Nobody will be working the check point until that time.
2. You must have a 5lb fire extinguisher at your sight within reach from your firebox. Paola Fire Dept will be coming around checking for this.
3. Meat inspections will begin around noon Friday. Please have all meat ready for inspection after you have set up your area.
4. You will be provided 4 wrist bands in your check-in packet. Please wear your wrist bands at all times. If you do not have your wrist bands on you will not be able to get through the gate. NO EXCEPTIONS.
5. You will have the opportunity to purchase 4 additional wrist bands at \$10 a piece, ONLY at the time of check-in so have the exact change ready when you check in.
6. Generators will be allowed as long as they do not bother the teams around you. If the noise becomes a problem you will be asked to turn off your generator. This will be up to the discretion of the BBQ staff.
7. Quiet time will be 30 minutes after the last band stops performing.
8. The cooks meeting will be at 6:30 p.m. on Friday night.
9. When turning in your entry at the judges tent please return to your area and DO NOT stand around the judges tent.
10. BBQ turn in times will be on Saturday as follows:
 - 11:30 AM Sausage
 - 12:00 PM Chicken
 - 12:30 PM Pork Ribs
 - 1:00 PM Pork Butt
 - 1:30 PM Brisket
11. Kids Q turn in times will be on Friday as follows:
 - 8:00 PM Hamburger
 - 8:30 PM Chicken Wings
